

The ABDN internships: fostering belonging and future prospects through work experience

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The ABDN Internships are a programme of part-time paid internships exclusively available to University of Aberdeen students sourced both from the University's Academic Schools/Professional Services and from local employers in key target sectors. Internships are financed through income generated from careers fairs, external funders and central University budgets. The internships aim to offer students opportunities for meaningful work experience which allows them to apply their skills and knowledge beyond the classroom, gaining confidence and building professional relationships. An extensive programme of support at every stage of the internship journey – from application to interview and throughout their internship experience – also allows us to engage with a large number of students from all years and Academic Schools, equipping them with employability skills to set them up for success in competitive graduate labour markets.
